Tournament Information

This is a 3 game guarantee duck soup style 6/4 benefit tournament. Teams can also play 7/5. Lineup rule is 3 guys cannot bat in a row. You come as a team, you leave as a team (no changing teams and when your team is out so are you). Teams caught "picking up" players who have already been knocked out of the tournament will be forced to take an out for that player for the rest of the tournament and that player will not be allowed to play. Teams caught doing it twice will be asked to leave.

The following innings will be played:

1. One Pitch, no courtesy foul
2. Bat opposite hand
3. Kick ball
4. Run bases in reverse order
5. Inside-out (the outfield players will play on the infield and the infielders will move to the outfield).
6. 4 out inning
 - Person who makes the last out of the inning will be the catcher in the next inning, unless that person is the pitcher, then the 2nd out of the inning plays catcher.
 - The last batter on the team scores 3 runs when they cross the plate, only if they are wearing the designated Frontier Western Days Bandana.
 - Each team is allowed one offensive or defensive mulligan (do-over) per game.
 - Courtesy foul will be allowed except during the 1 pitch inning.
 - Away team begins with a 1/2 run lead so there are no extra inning games.
 - Game balls will be classic m or classic plus for men and classic w for women. USSSA stamped bats only.
 - Players are able to purchase unlimited homeruns by purchasing a \$5 wrist band. Any homeruns that are hit without wearing a band will be deemed an out.
 - Teams will also need to provide their own score books and home team keeps score. Home vs. Away will be designated by a winning a stick-horse race!

Winning team will receive championship t-shirts, they will be ordered and mailed to winning team after the tournament so we can order appropriate sizes for each player.
