



Miss Frontier Western Celebration

Miss Frontier Western Celebration and her Court of Jr. Misses embody the spirit of our western theme and represent the festival throughout the weekend with appearances at several events.

The next Miss Frontier Western Celebration pageant will be held August 4th, 2019 at the Performing Arts Center in El Dorado, KS.

Please Review all Rules there has been some changes this year.

- Registration form and fee are due no later than 7p.m. July 21st, 2019. You will not be registered, otherwise. Registration is \$45 and \$30 for each addition child. This includes a 2019 pageant T-shirt and a FWC weekend pass. Title Holders will receive a 2nd weekend pass.
- Parents meeting is required and will be held at the El Dorado YMCA in the conference room. Sunday July 21st at 7pm.
- Head shots will be held at Rhythm and Blues Photography Studio located inside district 142, Tuesday, July 23rd at 6:30pm. Head shots are for the voting of Miss Photogenic and the pageant program. There are no makeup headshots and no personal photos will be used.
- Practice will begin on Saturday, July 27th. Each applicant will receive a schedule including practice days and times. If you are not able to attend a practice, the dance routine will need to be picked up on your own time.
- Dress rehearsals and costume check are mandatory.
- No bare midriffs allowed during practice or pageant activities. Shorts and skirts must be at an appropriate length. This length can be determined by the pageant director or co-director. If deemed inappropriate director/coordinator has the right to send contestant home to change.
- One female adult per child during practices and in dressing room on nights of dress rehearsal and pageant.
- No extra children at practices, or in dressing room.
- A previous year title holder can only participate in the following year if she has moved up to the next age group. If the title holder is in the same age group, 1 year must be skipped before she is eligible to compete again. Teen/Miss must meet all eligibility requirements to compete in Miss Kansas.
- The festival titleholder, Miss Frontier Western Celebration will be required to attend events throughout the weekend; though she may attend any and all other events.
- Must check in at festival headquarters at the Civic Center to receive passes.
