



Miss Frontier Job Description & Qualifications

Miss Frontier is an open title for young women between the ages of 17-24 (Must be between the ages of 18-24 by June 1, 2020).

Must be a Kansas resident and attending college or enrolled to attend college the 2019-2020 academic year.

As an ambassador for the HollyFrontier Western Celebration (HFWC), she will represent El Dorado Main Street (EMS) and the City of El Dorado during the 2019-20 festival year and at the Miss Kansas Pageant in June 2020.

She will conduct herself in a manner that will bring respect to the title and crown of Miss Frontier, the HFWC, EMS, and the City of El Dorado.

She will promote HFWC and El Dorado in addition to promoting her personal platform as well as the values of community service and scholarship.

She will maintain consistent and regular contact with the Miss Frontier/El Dorado Director regarding her progress in the areas of scholarship, service, style and success as well as her appearance schedule.
